I learned that bullying is everywhere you go and there is a way to stop it.

I learned that by re-enacting other people's stories it gives them an image about what they could have done to prevent the situation.

I learned not to be shy, and what to do in a bullying situation.

I learned that being yourself is not a crime.

Using story-based interactive theatre to address school bullying

No More Bullying! is offered in two formats:

NMB performance series:

A team of five adult performers visits a school to carry out one or more performances. The team includes a facilitator, three actors, and musician. Performances are one hour with up to three performances per day.



NMB Leadership program:

Company members lead a series of 8 training workshops for 15-20 students. Following training, students join adult performers in a series of shows for student audiences in their school.

Students in the training group learn in depth about bullying and how they can make a difference.

Recommended for 6th grade and up.

No More Bullying! uses interactive theatre based on students' real-life experiences to build empathy and empowerment. Using the power of creative expression, our approach gives students a chance to learn and practice practical steps that witnesses or bystanders can take to make their school a safer and more respectful place.

Students gain

- a clear understanding of what bullying is and a vocabulary to talk about it;
- a deepened empathy for others;
- a sense of affirmation and relief for those who've been bullied;
- practical knowledge of what witnesses/ bystanders can do next time they witness bullying;
- for the majority of children, motivation and resolve to take those actions.



No More Bullying! complements other anti-bullying programs. It supports and strengthens the impact of ongoing programs such as the Olweus program or PBIS.

Hudson River Playback Theatre has provided NMB to schools in the Mid-Hudson Valley of New York since 1999. We have worked with over 25,000 students from K-12.
